Curriculum and Schedule of Proposed Course Offerings

Courses will be taken by cohorts of students. The first 18 credits of the program (first year) will be taken at the University of North Texas during fall and spring semesters. The second 18 credits of the program (second year) will be taken at CATIE during the following summer, fall, and spring semesters. New intakes of cohorts will occur every fall semester at UNT. All courses will be taught in English.

Prerequisite/Corequisite Course (3 hours max): HGMT 4860 Hospitality Business Strategies. HGMT 4860 is offered in the Summer 5W2 prior to the Fall semester in year 1 and the Fall semester in year 1. Or, students may have prerequisite competencies completed in their bachelor's degree prior to admission to the MS degree. The prescribed degree plan is shown below.
